Delighting in the Word Psalm 19

A / The Declaration of Creation

The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above **proclaims** his handiwork.

B / The Public Word / General Revelation

Day to day pours out speech, night to night reveals knowledge. There is no speech, nor are there words, whose voice is not heard.

Their voice goes out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world.

In them he has set a tent for the sun,

which comes out like a bridegroom leaving his chamber,

and, like a strong man, runs its course with joy. Its rising is from the end of the heavens, and its circuit to the end of them, and there is **nothing hidden** from its heat.

C / God's Word, Special Revelation

- (1) The law of the Lord is perfect, reviving the soul;
- (2) the **testimony** of the Lord is **sure**, making wise the simple;
- (3) the precepts of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart;
- (4) the **commandment** of the Lord is **pure**, enlightening the eyes;
- (5) the fear of the Lord is clean, enduring forever;
- (6) the rules of the Lord are true, and righteous altogether.
- (7) More to be desired are they than gold, even much fine gold;
- (8) **sweeter** also than honey and drippings of the honeycomb.
- (9) Moreover, by them is your servant warned; in keeping them there is great **reward**.

B / The Private Word / Application

Who can discern his errors?

Declare me innocent from hidden faults.

Keep back your <u>servant</u> also from presumptuous sins; let them not have dominion over me!

Then I shall be blameless, and innocent of great transgression.

A / The Declaration of the Psalmist

Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in your sight, O Lord, my rock and my redeemer.

COMPLETE

Image of Invisible God – Col 1:15-20 "Well pleased" - Matthew 3:17 Form of God, emptied -Phil 2:6-11

It is **complete** [without fault] ...can complete us

INCOMPLETE

We are growing – Phil 1:6 Our knowledge – 1 Cor 13:9-10 Nor arrived - Phil 3:12-14

SOLID

A Cornerstone - Isaiah 29:16 Rejected stone – Psalm 118:22 The Foundation – 1 Corinthians 3:11

WEAK

JUST

FAULTY

DEPENDABLE

It is dependable [tried and true] ...makes us righteous

INCONSISTENT

Faithful men? – Prov 20:6 Don't trust men – Jer 17:5-8 Don't trust – Isaiah 2:22

VALUABLE

Precious blood – 1 Peter 1:18-19 Precious Cornerstone - Isaiah 28:16

It is valuable [Gold = richest mineral] ...worth our investments

LESS VALUE / but valuable

Image of God - Genesis 1:26-27 Jesus died for us – John 3:16

PLEASANT

I will give you rest – Matt 11:28-30 Messiah pleasant – Psalm 45:2

It is **sweet** and **pleasant** [sugar like] ...we should desire it

Desire Pleasant Things

Desire sweetness - Prov 24:13-14 Gracious words - Prov 16:24 The Sweet Scroll - Ezekiel 3:3

It is the source of both... warning – potential judgement and **reward** – potential glory

... And gives them a reward, salvation and sonship in Christ by grace through faith!
