I know you are enduring patiently and bearing up for my name's sake, and you have not grown weary.		
Diagnosis / Prognosis	But I have this against you, that you have abandoned the love you had at first.		
Cure / Warning	Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent, and do the works you did at first.  If not, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place, unless you repent.		
Encouragement	Yet this you have: you hate the works of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate.		
Closing Comments	He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To the one who conquers I will grant to eat of the tree of life, which is in the paradise of God.'
